Re: Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed 1E and 1E Alternate Greenfield Transmission Line and Wasatch Wind Turbine Farm, Albany and Converse Counties

Gentlemen:

Enclosed with our earlier letter dated June 3, 2009, we forwarded 305 Petitions against Rocky Mountain Power's proposal to build 1E or 1E Alternate through the Laramie Range Mountains. Additionally, we included 171 petitions against Wasatch Wind's proposal to build wind turbines in the Laramie Range Mountains. In an effort to keep you current with the numbers, we include 56 more Gateway West Citizen Petitions and 54 more Wasatch Wind Petitions bringing the total now to **361** Gateway West Citizen Petitions opposing the greenfield transmission project and **225** Wasatch Wind Petitions opposing the development of large scale wind farms in the Laramie Mountains.

The Northern Laramie Range Alliance came together to work with government and with private ag industry, conservation, and environmental organizations to prevent this industrialization. Since our organizing meeting in early May, we have grown to over 340 members. We are trying to ensure that activities of firms such as Wasatch and PacifiCorp are conducted in the full light of day and with appropriate opportunity for the views of the public to be heard. We support responsible wind-energy development in the high plains areas of Wyoming in which it is suitable, and we will be working with government officials to craft the policies needed to ensure that turbines go where they are appropriate and do not go where they are not appropriate.
