



## **YOUR FEEDBACK NEEDED ON PROPOSED INDUSTRIAL WIND ENERGY FACILITY IN CONVERSE COUNTY'S MOUNTAINS**

Dear Friends,

Wasatch Wind, Inc., a wind energy promoter based in Park City, Utah, is attempting to install an industrial-scale wind energy facility on 30,000 acres of land in the Boxelder-Mormon Canyon area of the Converse County mountains. It calls this proposed facility "Pioneer Wind Park," and currently has a campaign underway in Glenrock in an effort to create the impression that the public supports this facility. The photo below, taken from Mormon Canyon Road, shows much of the terrain on which, according to its website and other public statements, Wasatch would install its industrial plant.



Wasatch has said that its development would have 66 turbines of the size of those installed in the industrial facilities north of Glenrock, plus the transmission line, roads and other infrastructure associated with a wind farm of this scale. It also has told Converse County that it plans to transport all of this equipment through the La Prele Creek watershed, and over Cold Springs, Windy Ridge, Boxelder and Mormon Canyon Roads. These roads will have to be widened, straightened and graded, and bridges rebuilt, in order to accommodate these shipments.

**We now are offering all Converse County citizens an opportunity to express their views about this development: FOR, AGAINST or NO OPINION.** We would very much appreciate your completing and returning the enclosed postcard, which is the only opportunity all of the citizens of our County will have to let their public officials, and Wasatch Wind, know clearly and explicitly whether this is a development we want in the Converse County mountains.
